TODAY'S STUDY

Read John 14:1-14.

• How do you feel about what Jesus said in verses 1-3? Why?



- What did the apostles learn in verses 4-14?
- Have you learned and internalized what the apostles learned? How do you know?

Read John 14:15-31.

- What do you understand Jesus is saying about the Holy Spirit?
- Explain Jesus' statement, "Because I live, you also will live."
- Discuss our love for God and His for us.
- Jesus said (verse 23), "... we will come to him and make our home with him." How is this manifest to us?

• By implication, what would be true of you if you are agitated and upset? What should you do about it?

Read John 15:1-17.

- Who are the "actors" in this scripture?
- Jesus talked about 3 levels of fruit: no fruit, fruit, more fruit and much fruit. What fruit is Jesus talking about? What does it look like?
- How do you go from no fruit to much fruit?
- What is the key to remaining in Jesus?
- Why (for what purpose) did Jesus save you? What job did He give you?
- What can you expect as you obey Jesus?
