• What theme do you find here and in the remainder of these two chapters?



- Why do you think the soldiers and officials felt down when Jesus identified Himself?
- Where did Jesus say none of the disciples would be lost? Why is this important?
- Peter took action? What would you have done?
- Compare verse 11 with Matthew 16:13-23. What conclusions do you draw. How do they apply to you?

Read John 18:12-27.

- What did you find in your research about Jewish trials? Compare with this scripture passage.
- What was Jesus' response to the questioning by the high priest?

• Compare yourself and Peter.

Read John 18:28-19:16.

- What do you think about the Jews' unwillingness to enter Pilate's palace?
- What was Jesus charged with before the Sanhedrin? See Matthew 26:63-66 and Mark 14:61-64.
- What charges did the Jews bring to Pilate about Jesus? See Luke 23:1-2.
- Who is Jesus?
- Whose idea was it to crucify Jesus?
- What did you find out in your research on crucifixion?
- Did Jesus have to die on the cross? Why or why not?
- What do you notice about how Jesus died? Thoughts?
