TODAY'S LESSON

Read John 20:1-20.

- Compare this with verse 29 and with Paul's experience in Acts 26:15-18. Does this apply to us? Why or why not?

Read John 20:22-29.

- What do you think about Thomas? What is true about him?
- What role did faith play in Thomas' belief?
- What did Jesus say about this?

- Compare this with John 14:10-11 and John 17:20-22.

Read John 21:1-14.

- What is Jesus doing in this passage?
- Why does the scripture say, “None of the disciples dared ask him, ‘Who are you?’ They knew it was the Lord.”?

Read John 21:15-19.

- What is Jesus doing here? What is His objective?
- Is there an application for us? If so, what is it?

Read John 21:20-25.

- What is Jesus’ message to Peter and to us?
- Link verse verses 22-23 with verse 19. Thoughts?
