Read John 3:4-8.

Read John 3:9-15.

- How do you think Nicodemus understood what Jesus said?
- What application would you make of what Jesus said?
- Check out Numbers 21:4-9. Does this make you want to revise your answer? If so, do it.

Read John 3:16-23.

- There is a lot of practical theology in these verses. What things do you see?
- Why do you think some people (maybe you) do not receive Jesus as their Lord and Savior?
- What is your understanding of light and darkness that Jesus mentioned?
- Taking John 3:1-23 as a whole, what might you need to do?
- Have you done it? If not, what are you waiting for?

Read John 3:24-36.

- Identify the truths John mentioned. How do they apply to you?
- Compare John 3:36 with John 3:18. What truths do you see?

Read John 4:1-9.

- What do you think or know about this situation?

Read John 4:10-26.

- What is going on here and why?
- Why all the business about the woman's husband?

Read John 4:27-38.

- What lesson(s) ought we to learn from this passage? Compare with Matthew 9:37-38.
- What, if anything, do you personally need to do?

Read John 4:39-42.

- How might this passage apply today?

Read John 4:43.

- What application, if any, is there for you?

Read John 4:44-54.

- Identify the key phrase in this passage. Why did you choose it?
