TODAY'S LESSON

Read John 9:1-5.



- What are the implications for you in verse 3? What do you think about that?
- What did Jesus mean in verses 4 and 5. What might that have to do with us?

Read John 9:6-12.

- Compare verse 7 with Luke 17:14.
- Why did Jesus have the man go and wash his eyes?
- What was happening in verses 8 to 12?

Read John 9:13-34.

• Compare verse 16 with John 7:21-24. What conclusion can you draw about how we should function?

- Look at verses 22 and 34. Talk about the importance of the synagogue to the Jews and relate this to us and to mission work.
- Discuss the exchange between the man and the Pharisees in verses 24-33. How might this relate to you?

Read John 9:35-41.

- Read Hebrews 11:6. What condition was the man in when Jesus healed Him?
- When did the man exhibit faith in Jesus? In what way did he do so?
- Talk about spiritual blindness. Can real Christians be spiritually blind? Explain.
